The School – Bible Baptist School is a college preparatory Christian school for students in grades K-12. BBS offers a challenging academic and competitive athletic program.

Mission Statement - As a mission of Bible Baptist Church, and in partnership with the family, Bible Baptist School students will come to the realization of their need for the saving grace of Jesus Christ, mature in their faith, demonstrate Christian character, develop their God-given talents and be academically and intellectually prepared to engage the world and thereby impact generations to the glory of God.

Accreditation - Bible Baptist School is fully accredited by the Georgia Private School Accreditation Council (GAPSAC) which is approved and recognized by the State Board of Education of Georgia. BBS also is a member of the American Association of Christian Schools (AACCS) and competes athletically in the South Carolina Independent School Athletic Association (SCISAA).

Faculty – A teacher student ratio of 1:12 allows the school’s diverse faculty to provide individualized attention in a caring Christian environment. Each classroom teacher is qualified and certified through our state organization.

Graduation Requirements – Students begin earning credits toward graduation in the ninth grade. A minimum of 24 credits is required for graduation.

- Science.....4 credits
- Bible.....4 credits
- Foreign Language2 credits
- Computer.....2 credits
- Physical Education.....1 credit

Electives include Yearbook, speech, drama, choir and Teacher’s Aide program.

Non-Academic Requirements – Students in the 9-12 are required to complete 80 hours of community service for graduation. In addition the seniors take a Senior Missions Trip.

Athletics – Bible Baptist School has a very competitive athletic program offering over 10 sports and 21 teams. Some programs are offered from the 3rd grade.

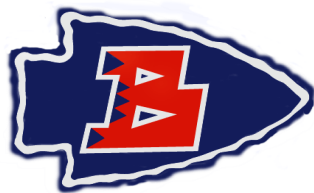
Recent College Acceptance
